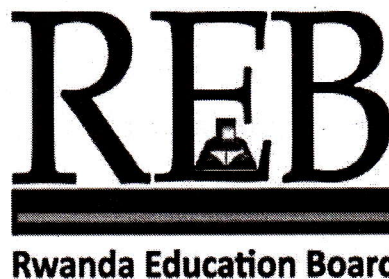

- 5) Explain the reasons that led to the growth of Buganda kingdom. **(25marks)**
- 6) What role did the long distance trade play in the formation of states in East Africa? **(25marks)**
- 7) Analyze the effects of Belgian colonization in Rwanda. **(25marks)**
- 8) Examine the reasons why colonialists introduced different administrative systems after the establishment of colonial rule in Africa. **(25marks)**
- 9) Describe the effects of the decolonization of the African continent. **(25marks)**
